As of 4.6.98 on a television news feed early in the morning, the story was sent on news feed NAO52 that the following rivers had been placed in the Environmental Species Act. These rivers were parts of the Columbia, Missouri River, (all states) Polomoke River, Kern River, Ca. and the Blackfoot River, Mont. It is my opinion that the Regulation being used to do this will make no distinction between Public Land and Private Land. If that proves to be the case, when any enforcement of the Regulation were to take place, the conditions stated in the Regulation would apply. Two weeks ago I sent to your Southwest Regional Protection division, to the attention of Mr. Wingert, my letter in protest to your Regulation as posted in the Federal Register: Nov. 25, 1997, Vol. 62, Number 227 pages 62741 - 62751.

To date I have received no acknowledgment of this letter or protest. I do not know if it was received and catalogued by this office. Since the outcome of this opposition could effect property rights along all rivers and streams throughout the United States I feel it is imperative that my voice be heard and common curtseys that my objection be acknowledged.

This regulation is not tolerable in any form, using any endangered specie, for any land in the United States of America. It completely usurps Constitutional Law and the Right of the People for ownership of private land. It further infringes on their basic Right to Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness, and under the 5th Amendment, denies them *just compensation*.
